# Adoration

Adoration is the act of adoring God, of loving Him purely for who He is. To adore Him involves quiet, unhurried reflection upon His character. David spoke of his desire to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord (Psalm 27:4).

# Confession

Confession involves acknowledging our sins and our sinfulness to God and seeking the mercy and forgiveness promised to all believers who confess their sins. Confession is often natural after a time of adoration because we see ourselves in the light of God's holiness.

It can be very meaningful to personalize the Scripture in confession, inserting one's own name into the text.

# Supplication

Supplication is a time of asking God to do something. Most prayers consist primarily of supplication. Yet without adoration, confession and thanksgiving, we often fail to make intelligent requests of God.

This section is divided into three sections:

1. Scriptural prayers requesting God to build spiritual qualities in a person. Such prayers should be personalized as we pray them for ourselves and for others. As we study the Word, we should be looking for passages of Scripture that command us to develop such traits. The Beatitudes (Matthew 5) or Paul's list of the qualities of the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23) give us a biblical basis for praying. And when we pray for these things we know that we are praying for the things God wants.
2. Suggestions in praying for the salvation of others. There are two lists: one of suggestions of ways for us to pray for ourselves as we share the gospel, and one of suggestions of ways to pray for the unsaved. These lists, included on pages 47-48, are taken from a prayer card. You will find many additional Scripture references on these pages.
3. Blank pages for you to list your own favorite Scripture portions.

May you be strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy, giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.

2. That we speak the truth of Christ clearly. Colossians 4:2-4.

4. That we not fear intimidation, but sanctify Christ as Lord in our hearts. John 17:14-19; Philippians 1:27-30; 1 Peter 3:13-15.
5. That we be alert to and resist the schemes of the devil. Ephesians 6:10-12; 1 Peter 5:8-9.
6. That we keep our behavior excellent among believers. Ephesians 5:1-17; Philippians 1:27; Colossians 4:5-6; 1 Peter 1:14-16; 2:12.
