(1) Moses' Status

(a) He was a prophet (*nābî*).

(b) He rose up (*qûm*).

(2) Moses' Incomparable Role

(a) No other prophet enjoyed the intimacy of relationship he had with YHWH, here described as YHWH knowing him face to face.

(b) No other prophet performed such signs and wonders.
