Job Title: Pastor of Evangelism

Reporting: Reports to and is under the direct supervision of the Executive Pastor, works in cooperation with the Missions

Pastor and is accountable to the Council of Elders

Primary
Objective:

As part of the Discover pathway, provide leadership to a comprehensive strategy for evangelism to those who are not yet following Christ so that they may grow into loving and devoted followers of Jesus Christ.

Principal Duties:

1. Oversee evangelistic ministries of the church, including but not limited to:

- Christianity Explored
- Evangelistic Outreach Events such as Summer Celebration, Tuesdays Together, special one-off events and the like
- Front door ministries who are the first people encountered by those new to the church (and Christianity)
- Sports Ministries/Upward Basketball
- Arts Ministries
- Each One to Reach One
- Livestream viewers, finding ways to reach out to them with effective gospel witness and connecting them to a Bible-preaching church
- 2. Equip and mentor congregants to embrace evangelism
 - Mobilize congregation to serve our communities in loving ways to reach others with the gospel
 - Mentor congregants to embrace those in their spheres of influence with love and service so
 when the time is appropriate, an invitation to come to worship will be effective
 - Work closely with the Missions Pastor to include area missions workers in mentoring others and performing outreach functions
- 3. Be actively involved in personally reaching out to others in the community and within his personal spheres to convey the gospel
- 4. Work closely with the Evangelism and Culture Impact Committee
 - Review, evaluate and recruit CCIW-supported evangelists and assign to strategic areas of DuPage County
 - Cross-pollinate ideas with other evangelists and congregants
 - Schedule events with dynamic guest speakers to draw the community to hear the gospel presented in winsome ways
 - Schedule special class or classes to demonstrate how to reach out with the gospel message
- 5. Share in the pastoral care of the congregation including preaching, teaching, officiating at weddings and funerals and visitation.
- 6. Perform other duties as directed by the Senior Pastor.
