# A LEGACY OF PROCLAIMING THE GOSPEL IN WHEATON


Since 1861, College Church in Wheaton has stood for the gospel of Jesus Christ.



# THE ACTION


What will this look like? Starting with a new prayer focus and sermon series in April 2024 and continuing with an invitation to participate financially, we will accelerate our **Gospel Now** vision in two major ways:

# ELEVATE LOCAL OUTREACH.

We will transform the Crossings building into a vibrant hub for community, worship and growth with spaces that foster gospelcentered relationships, learning and spiritual development.

## ENHANCE MINISTRY READINESS.

We will significantly increase accessibility on our campus, reducing barriers that hinder our more vulnerable attenders. We also commit to reducing and hopefully eliminating our debt, ensuring future financial stability for College Church's vision. These bold steps will equip us to thrive amidst cultural and economic changes for God's glory.

#### **ELEVATED LOCAL OUTREACH**

The Crossings is envisioned as a dynamic environment that attracts and connects our church family to community outreach opportunities, while concurrently intensifying our commitment to discipleship and spiritual development for people of all ages. It will become the new home for our middle school, high school and college ministries and be especially suited for children, students and their parents.

#### THE ACTION

By adding a café, a children's play area, mixed-use spaces for church and community programming and dedicated areas for student engagement, the Crossings will provide a warm and engaging environment for the gospel to thrive.

The total anticipated cost to transform the Crossings into this crossover hub for gospel outreach and investing in younger generations is \$4.0 million. **CAFÉ/MULTIPURPOSE SPACE**—A bright and comfortable environment to engage with friends while enjoying specialty coffees, pastries and light fare. Also can be utilized as a space suited for large gatherings such as College Group, Men's Bible Study and conferences. The dining space is fully equipped with audio and video capabilities and a temporary stage.

**PLAYSPACE CHILDREN'S AREA**—A safe and contained play area for children that will enable parents to keep an eye on their kids while enjoying the café.

**GAMESPACE CHILDREN'S AREA**—Pool, foosball and other table games for older children and students.

**ARTSPACE GALLERY AREAS**—ArtSpace Gallery areas for viewing community art, with additional art displayed on other walls of the Crossings.

**COLLABORATION SPACE**—Meeting spaces throughout the facility for discipleship, counseling and other pastoral-care activities, designed to facilitate private, scheduled conversations.

KITCHEN AND LIVING ROOM—A cozy space with sofas and a kitchen, designed to replicate the comfort and atmosphere of a home kitchen and family room for Grace Groups, GriefShare, Mom2Mom and other small-group gatherings.

**WORSHIP/STUDENT SPACES**—Spacious worship rooms for KMs and HYACKS. One of these rooms can be expanded to hold gatherings of up to 300 people. Both are fully equipped with audio and video capabilities to support worship and conference activities.

**LIVING ROOMS**—One room adjacent to the cafe and one upstairs above the south entry perfect for private small gatherings.

#### OUR GOSPEL NOW VISION

We want to make College Church a friendlier place for the curious, the struggling, and the unchurched. Increasing accessibility as well as creating a warm and welcoming public space in the new Crossings will help us do that. And we are committed to the greater flexibility for future needs that will be made possible by reducing debt. These bold steps will equip us to thrive as we focus on God's glory in challenging times so we can even more effectively proclaim the gospel now and in the years ahead.

## ACCESSIBILITY: PAVING THE WAY FOR THE GOSPEL

The addition of parking closer to the main entrance of the sanctuary building is an impactful change that will make it easier for individuals with mobility challenges or special needs to access our worship service, ensuring that no one is excluded from the warmth and fellowship of College Church. The total funds remaining to be raised to prepare the site and construct accessible parking closer to the main entrance as well as a storage shed for outdoor equipment is \$1.1 million.

## FINANCIAL STABILITY: A FOUNDATION FOR GROWTH

We recognize the importance of financial stability in accelerating our vision. Therefore, we are dedicated to reducing and ultimately eliminating our debt, laying a solid foundation for College Church's future endeavors. Our goal is to raise \$3.4 million or more to reduce our outstanding obligations.

Through prudent financial management and strategic planning, we will streamline our operations, optimize our resources, and steward our finances with integrity and foresight, ensuring long-term sustainability for the ministries of College Church.
