## **FRANCE**

<u>Dates</u>: October 5–13, 2024

<u>Team activities</u>: Evangelism, relational opportunities, English as a Second Language

Skills needed: Willingness to talk to strangers, servant attitude, flexibility, willing to

be on the sidelines, when necessary, and pray

Physical requirements: Must be able to walk three (3) miles daily comfortably

Team size: 6-10



## **THAILAND**

Have a heart for kids? Serve global families by discipling their children of all ages during annual retreat in Chiang Mai, Thailand. This is also an opportunity to encourage and support global workers Daniel and Julie and their sons, Ben and Timothy.

<u>Dates</u>: December 28, 2024–January 7, 2025.

<u>Team activities</u>: VBS, discipleship, worship

<u>Skills needed</u>: Love kids (infant through high school), flexibility, servant attitude, ability to plan and/or carry out fun activities and mentor kids

<u>Physical requirements</u>: Must be able to navigate stairs as no elevators are available at the retreat center; possible mildew due to humidity

Team size: 10-20
