PRAYER & SCRIPTURE MEMORY

EPHESIANS 1:16-19A

A Prayer for Wisdom

I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe...

PRAYING

Ephesians 1:16-19a

Use the passage as a guide for your own prayer. You might pray something like:

***We pray that you, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give us the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of you, that the eyes of our hearts would be enlightened, that we may know what is the hope to which you have called us, what are the riches of your glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of your power toward us who believe...
(based on Ephesians 1:16-19a)***

Praise God for who he is—the Father of glory. Pause to add your own prayers of praise.

Ask God to fill you with his Spirit, that you might be filled with wisdom and Thank God for the hope he has called you to and ask him to give you even greater knowledge and trust of that hope.

Add your own prayers for a greater understanding of God. Ask that God would use that growing understanding to overflow into sharing about the hope you have in him. Take time to pray for your “one,” asking God to open his or her eyes to his greatness as well.
